## A Guide to the Compton (Lord Alwyne) Collection of Tile Tracings in the Society of Antiquaries, London

**The project:** The organization of the collection of loose tile drawings, rubbings, and tracings into four red boxes and three oversized folders, and the cataloguing of these materials, was begun in March 1998 and completed the following year. The resulting database, prepared with Microsoft Access, provides an index to the collection.

**The Collection:** Lord Alwyne Compton (1825-1906), undertook in the mid-1840s to document as many medieval tile patterns as he could find. With the help of A.W. Franks he traveled widely to trace old tiles. Friends who learned of his project sent him tile tracings. His interest in the designs had probably been inspired in part by the work of John Gough Nichols who had published earlier in the decade his illustrated study of encaustic tiles, and who later printed tile designs for Compton.<sup>1</sup> Compton bequeathed his collection to the Society of Antiquaries. It consists mostly of British tile designs with a few from France, Italy, Portugal, and Spain.

**I. Red Boxes (1-4).** Loose tile designs on paper have been organized into four boxes, each containing a three-ring binder of acid-free poly pages. Most of the designs represent single tiles but there are also plans of he pavements, some quite elaborate. Most are line drawings and tracings in graphite or ink on tissue paper, cut or torn to tile sizes; some are colored, a few are crayon rubbings; and there are a few printed designs. The box also contains a few autograph letters and some notes. The folios have been numbered consecutively through the four boxes.

**II. Green Box.** Contains two books.

**Book 1.** Grey embossed boards, broken spine. 31.5 x 24.5 cm. A loose unsigned note inside reads "Tracings, drawings, and rubbings of Gothic Tiles by the Rev. Lord Alwyne Compton, DD./ Some Bishop of Ely. Left by him to the Society of Antiquaries."

This is a scrapbook of miniature drawings of medieval tile designs, most of them pasted into loose signatures. The tile designs are arranged according to subject. They are hand-drawn and painted, mostly in brown and pale yellow (tile colours) with gouache or watercolour. Captions in black ink under each design describe the finder of the tile (initials or name) and the site where the tile existed in situ. A measuring scale occurs on the lower left corner of each page. The leafs are of tan wove paper, rather heavy and textured. The unbound signatures hold remnants of the red strings with which they were originally sewn. It is not clear whether the signatures are in their original order. They have been numbered for purposes of this index.

**Book 2.** A small sketchbook, 20.8 x 13.2 cm, with graph paper pages. Hard board covers, front cover detached. Title page reads "Drawings of Gothic tiles by Alwyne, Bishop of Ely from 1886 to 1906." Sketchbook contains miniature, intricately-detailed sketches of tiles, drawn first in graphite and then hand-coloured with brownish-red ink. The designs are traced and captioned in black ink. The designs, numbered by AC refer to an index of 244 entries on the last two pages of the book. The book is paginated to p. 111, with the remaining pages left blank. The index lists in order the tile number, the site, 'tracing by', and page number.

**III. Tiles.** A large scrapbook, 42.7 x 26.5 cm, with worn binding and a loose spine, titled "Tracings of Gothic Tiles by Alwyne Bishop of Ely from 1886 to 1906". An index in the front of the book lists sites. The scrapbook contains miscellaneous tipped-in tracings and sketches. A few letters and loose materials have been removed to **I: Red Boxes** or **IV: Oversized** portfolios.

**IV. Oversized drawings :** Three folders contain drawings, tracings, and rubbings too large to fit in the Red Boxes.. They are protected in poly sleeves and numbered as O-series (changed to numerical listing, 1-3: 1-70 in the database index).

### The Index

The index to the collection shows the order of the materials in the Red Boxes and the oversized tracings according to fields, as follows:

**Tile/tracing site:** as given by Compton (AC), usually on the tile tracing

**Building type:** as given by AC, if known

**County UK**

**I: Red Box Folios:** numbered in sequence through the four boxes for the present index

**IV: Oversized:** numbered for the present index

**Secondary Source:** as given by AC; these denote a collection in which he found a tile to trace

**Reference:** sources other than AC used to identify tile patterns, usually Eames.<sup>2</sup>

**Letters:** Autograph letters (ALS) found amongst the tracings

**Misc MSS:** notes, unidentified sketches, manuscripts, poems, etc.

**Foreign Tile Sites:** tiles from outside the UK

**II: Green Box: sketches:** see **II. Book 2**, above. [not completed]

**II: Green Box: subjects:** see **II. Book 1**, above. [not completed]

**III: Bound Scrapbook:** see **III. Tiles** above. Refers only to tracings in the Red Boxes [not printed in the index]
